Social Justice + Technology Work is important at 3 levels

- Individual & Interpersonal (Micro)
- Community, Organizational & Institutional (Mid)
- Policy (Macro)

Here are some resources to approach it at all three levels

- Assert that technology is not neutral.
- Value access and technology in all its forms.
- Reflect on what your actions say to others.
- Place people at the center.
- Speak from your experiences.
- Provide people time to process.
- You won't know unless you ask.
- Remember to step up, step back.
